# Your project should be...

- Neatly presented
- Full of interesting information
- Complete with text (hand written or word processed) and pictures/images
- Use the topics on the following slides to help you.
- Reminder! You do not need to complete every topic below – just try your best!



## Parts of your project



#### **Fact file**

- Give key information on your country: capital city, language, currency, population etc.
- Flag: include a drawing/image of the flag. Give a brief history about it.

#### **Climate**

 What weather does this country experience? What are the seasons like? How does this affect the people there?

### Geography

- Explain where your country is located- continent, bordering countries/oceans/seas.
- II. Give the size of your country, use maps to show this if you can.
  - III. Research the longest river, highest mountain and other interesting geographical attractions.



# Parts of your project cont...

#### **History**

- Give details of important people, key date and events.
- A timeline would be useful here- copy / print the example provided.

#### **Food and Drinks**

- Find details of drinks or dishes, which come from your chosen country.
- Are there any traditional dishes that are served at a particular time of year?
- Include images, drawings, recipes or menus.
- Are you a budding chef? Why not try making one of the dishes!

# Parts of your project cont...



#### **Culture**

- What pastimes do they have in this country?
- Do they have any traditional dances or customs?
- Is there any famous music/art/dance that comes from there?





### Famous people

- Which famous people or celebrities come from your chosen country?
- Why are they famous?

 Feel free to add any other information that you think would make your project more interesting.
