▪ **THE CREED:**

Fr. Kieran: Together let celebrate our trust in the God who saves us, God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit, as we pray the Creed together: The Apostle's Creed:
adapted from a version by Victor Hoagland, C.P.

- **Adult:** I believe in God, the Father almighty,
Creator of heaven and earth,
- **Young Person:** Everything I see - the earth, the sky, the sea, the stars - are gifts of God to me.
All say: Amen, we believe.
- **Adult:** and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
- **Young Person:** And I believe God's greatest gift is Jesus Christ, God's only Son, who came to earth to be my friend and brother forever.
All say: Amen, we believe.
- **Adult:** who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary,
- **Young Person:** Jesus was born in Bethlehem, long ago;
he was born of the Holy Spirit, God's breath, and Mary was his mother.
All say: Amen, we believe.
- **Adult:** suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried;
- **Young Person:** Jesus, so good, was put to death on a cross by Pontius Pilate, a Roman governor, and all seemed lost when he was buried in a tomb, but it wasn't.
- **All say:** Amen, we believe.

- **Adult:** he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.
- **Young Person:** I believe God the Father raised Jesus from the dead. On Easter Sunday, his friends saw him alive,
and they were filled with joy. God the Father made Jesus the judge of all things.
All say: Amen, we believe.
- **Adult:** I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.
- **Young Person:** Yes, the Holy Spirit gives life to me, too,
and not only to me, but to all the friends of Jesus,
who are his family, the church.
We follow the successor of the Apostle Peter.
The Holy Spirit forgives our sins,
and gives us the promise of life with God forever. Amen.

The ticking of the clock




The popping of the toaster

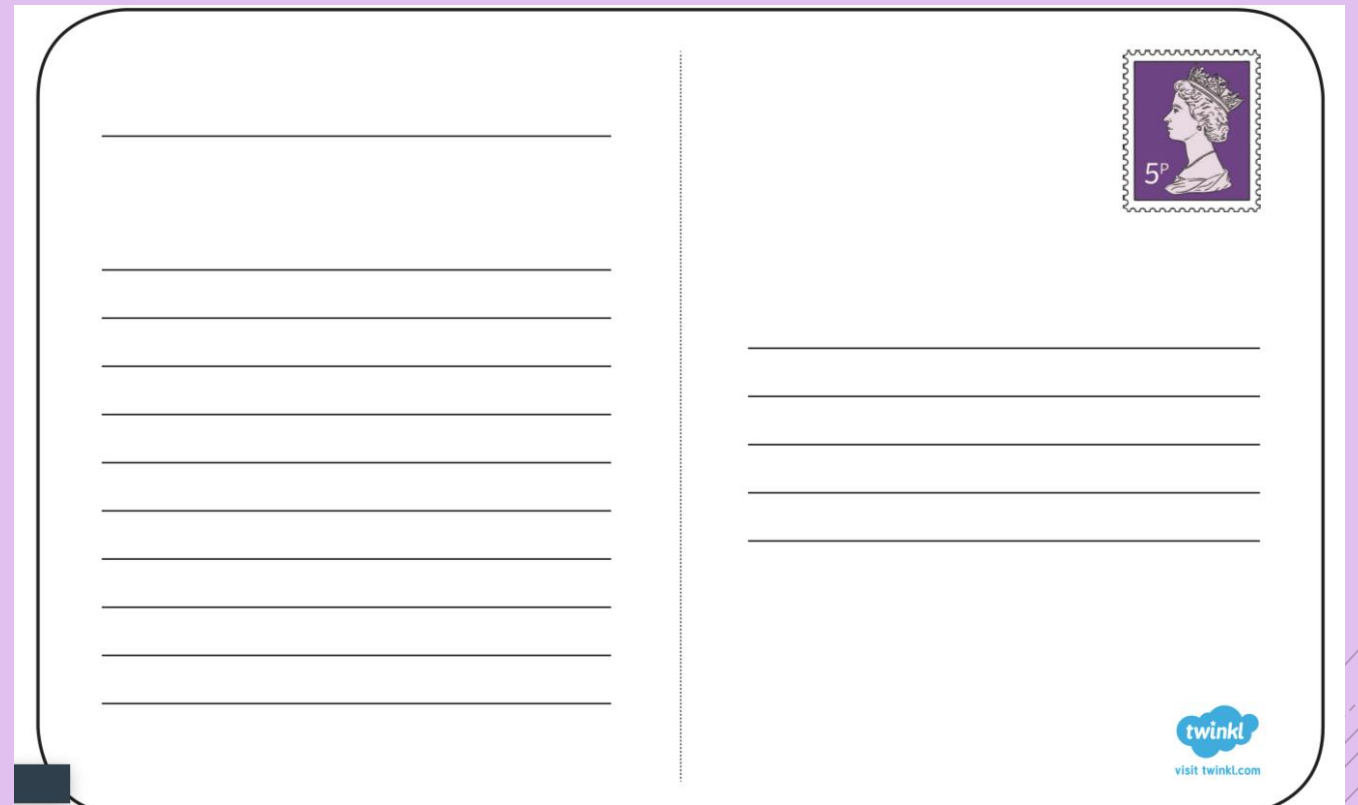
