School Times

1st Class to 6th Class School commences at 8.40am and finishes at 14.25. Pupils attending appointments during school hours must be collected by their parents or guardians and signed out.

Please be on time for school every day.

Good attendance is a priority in our school. If you bring your child late, leave early ,or your child is absent from school, you need to provide the teacher with a note. The teacher has to take an attendance roll every day and put in a "reason for absence"

Parents of children arriving late or leaving early need to sign in/out. If you have an appointment and your child will be late for school, please let the teacher know.

Parents will be informed once a child has reached 15 absent days.

School Dress Code

Uniform Pupils must wear their school uniform at all times, including the school tie. School tracksuits are only allowed on timetabled PE days.

Label Please label all your child's clothes.

Weather Weather and a rain jacket in milder weather.

Shoes Please get your child shoes with Velcro straps. Young children usually cannot manage laces.

Tips for buying schoolbags, lunchboxes and school equipment.

Make sure your son's schoolbag is big enough to fit : an A4 folder, his lunchbox, pencil case and occasional other school items.

We do not recommend schoolbags with wheels for Junior Infants as they are a trip hazard.

Make sure your son can open and close his lunchbox and water bottle with ease.

School items such as books (purchased by Dept of Education Stationary, Extras as per Booklist will be purchased by school.

Put your son's name on all his belongings.



Safety, Health and Welfare

If your child has an allergy, medical condition, problem with sight or hearing, or is being assessed by a health professional or has any specific needs, please inform the school prior to September.

- If you have any medical reports on your child which may have an impact on their ability to learn, please share it with your child's teacher.
- Head lice: It is important that hair is checked regularly, and treated if necessary. If your child has head lice please inform the class teacher and a note will be sent home to advise all parents to check their sons' hair.
- Send a note in with the child to explain the absence when they return to school.


Spreading of Contagious Bugs

Help your child to become as independent as possible over the summer


It would help greatly if your child is able to:

- button and unbutton a coat and hang it up
- use the toilet without help and manage trouser buttons. Elastic waist is best
- practise personal hygiene and cleanliness. Your child should know how to <u>flush the toilet and wash hands</u>, without being told.
- use a tissue and cover their mouth when sneezing and coughing
- share toys and games with others and "take turns"
- tidy up and put away play things.
- open and close and pack their lunchbox and school bags

- Children's moral and social education is covered right through the school day e.g. kindness to others, sharing and saying sorry.


